- **Contributing gifts and appreciation packages** for our community volunteers, donors, and supporters. - **Organising and helping with the Official Opening** for the new building – date to be announced. Andrew Sheerin will be coordinating this – please get in touch if you have any ideas or would like to be involved.
- **Donating items such as construction timber, fixings, tools, kitchens** that might be useful for our project. If you have anything lying around your workshop that you haven't touched in a while, please consider donating to the club.
